Newspaper coverage

Infotrac Newspaper database

A collection of 45 UK newspapers, both national and regional, and several international newspapers, with daily updates and archives back to 1996 for several titles.

Search by subject keyword, date, or newspaper title. To narrow down your search, tick the box 'Arts and Entertainment' so only stories in that section of each newspaper is searched- this is where most articles about literature will be.

To search on a particular newspaper, type in the newspaper's name next to the 'Browse' button on the initial search page, or click on it to browse the list of newspapers, then click on the one(s) you want. You can also search by specific date of publication.

Also:

- The Times** - has book reviews in the Saturday edition
- The Guardian** - has a section called Saturday Review which contains book reviews
- The Observer** - has book reviews in the Observer Review section
- The Daily Telegraph** - has a Books and Arts sections on Saturdays
- The Financial Times** - has an arts section on Tuesdays
- The New York Times** - has a Book Review desk in the Sunday edition
